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Dear Parents and Carers,

Where has the year gone? We only have three weeks to go until the end of the school year. It has been a great year at Bevendean.

Mrs Hammond will start at Bevendean at the end of the Summer holidays in preparation for the start of the new school year. We welcome her to the Bevendean team! The final letter for the year will be sent home on Friday 7th July with details about next year's classes. Your child will receive their end of year school report on Friday 14th July. Please see your child's class teacher if you would like to discuss this further. Our transition day is Wednesday 12th July. Your child's new teacher will be available to meet with you between 3.15pm and 3.45pm that day.

Residential Trips for Years 5 & 6

Year 5 had an amazing time at their recent residential trip to Parkwood. They did so many activities including orienteering, Trust Games, Scavenger Hunt, Water Obstacles challenge and of course their favourite, Catch the Flag. Camp fires were lit and enjoyed with the toasting and tasting of marshmallows in the evening. The weather was glorious and it made it a really enjoyable time for all. The children's behaviour was excellent.

Year 6 children's residential trip to Blackland Farm starts tomorrow so please ensure everything is ready; there are still a few payments outstanding, forms etc. to sort out. If your child needs medication to be administered during the trip, remember to put it in a named bag and give it to their class teacher on the day of their departure. 2017 – 2018 Charity Events

We will again be celebrating and acknowledging a number of charities next year with our emphasis and commitment to be supporting local charities. These will be our Harvest celebrations, (last year we gave goods to the local homeless) Chestnut Tree House and 'Sports for Schools' Olympic Athletes; a Sports event where the school will be raising some money for the school too. Most of these charity events fall in the October/November time; keeping this in mind and the fact that it is near Christmas, (an expensive time of year), we will not be doing a specific fundraising for Children in Need, but children may, if they wish, dress up in spots or the colours of Pudsey spots and bring in a donation of £1.00 which we will then send on.

Leave of absence from school during term time

If you are considering taking your child out of school during term time for whatever reason, it is necessary to fill in an application form. This form must be submitted at least 14 days prior to the date you wish to remove your child.

It is only in exceptional circumstances that this will be authorised.

If the time you request is not authorised and you still take your child out of school we will have to notify the Behaviour & Attendance Team and they may issue you with a Penalty Notice. The penalty is issued to each parent for each child taken out of school. This is a fine of £60 which increases to £120 if not paid within the first 28 days. Non payment of the fine may result in legal action.

Please note that Brighton and Hove Council have lengthened the October half term holiday from one week to two (16th - 27th October) and our school will be holding its last two Inset days on Monday 24th and Tuesday 25th July, allowing the children to break up on Friday 21st July, enabling holiday bookings within a cheaper period.

If you do know that you won't be back in time for Monday 4th September when the new term starts, because you are still on holiday, please let the school office know before the end of the Summer term. You will need to fill out a holiday request form as mentioned above.

Midday Meal Supervisor Vacancy
