Early Years Foundation Stage: Attainment

Children in Reception are assessed against the Early Learning Goals for the 17 Areas of Learning at the end of their Reception year, to ensure that they are ready for Year One. Children will either be Emerging, Expected or Exceeding the Early Learning Goals at the end of the year. In 2017 – 2018, 73% of our children achieved GLD (Good Level of Development).

Key Stage 1 SATS: Attainment

The National Curriculum is organised into Key Stages. Attainment and progress are measured across each Key Stage. Key Stage comprises learners in Year 1 & 2 (ages 5 - 7). In the second half of the Summer Term, children are assessed as to how well they perform in Reading, Writing, Maths and Phonics both against national standards and our own high standards.
