Dear Parents and Carers,

Our topic for this half-term is 'Ourselves'. We will be learning about families and homes. We will also be talking about feelings and emotions. Another aspect will be learning about our bodies and how to keep healthy.

### English & Maths

- In English, we will soon be working on our 'Talk for Writing' story which is 'The Three Little Pigs'. The children will learn the repeated phrases like 'I'll huff, and I'll puff, and I'll blow your house down!' They will learn a reduced version of the story by heart, reinforced by actions and a 'story map'.
- We are beginning to recognise our names, from the coat peg labels and self-registering cards!
- In Maths we are learning to count and to recognise numbers 1-5.
- We are also learning the names of shapes and colours and how to sort things by those attributes.

# Forest Schools

- We will be starting Forest Schools on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> September. Children will be visiting the Nature Garden and learning about the plants and animals which live there.
- If your child has wellies of their own, please could you bring them to school on Wednesdays as we don't have enough spares for the whole class.

### Rhyme of the Week

• Each week the children will be learning a Nursery rhyme or song at school. To help them to learn it really well we will give each child a copy to take home, and would really appreciate it if you could practise this with your child!
