World War 2 – Hands on History

On the 12th of March year 6 participated in a “Hands on History” workshop. They learnt about many different aspects of World War 2 in fun and interactive way: dressing up, handling WW2 weapons and taking part in a real-life air raid.

World War 2 – Fabulous Finish

To celebrate all the amazing work the children have done this term during our World War 2 topic, we will be having a war-time tea party on the **Monday 26th of March (starting at 2:00 p.m.)** All parents and carers are invited to come to school and join in the fun. You will have an opportunity to see your children’s topic books, art work and join in the jive! We hope as many of you as possible will be able to make it.

What we are learning this term

Our History topic this term is World War 2 and this will be the basis for much of the work that we do. This includes learning about the experience of living through a war and how it impacted on many people’s lives. In English, we will be writing newspaper reports, diaries and biographies about key figures involved in the war, which we will learn about in our History lessons. For Maths we will begin working in our groups, learning about decimals and percentages, measure, algebra and statistics. We will also be doing some Maths linked to our topic where possible. In art, we are focussing on Henry Moore as well as some DT where we will make bunting. In Science, we will be learning about electricity.

Interventions

During the Spring term, we are holding open interventions focusing on SATs preparation. These interventions will continue to run from 8.30am, Monday to Thursday, and will focus on both English and Maths. We feel these will be beneficial to all students, as they will be targeted for pupil’s individual needs. You should have received a letter but if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak with us.
