Science- Plants


History/Geography- The Romans and the Celts

Our focus in Maths continues to be on our times tables. Children are aiming to be able to answer quick fire multiplication questions rather than counting up to find the correct answer, so regular practice, in school and at home, is key. Children should already be secure in their 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables and are currently working on learning the 4, 6 and 8 times tables.

Please continue to provide your child with a PE kit that can be kept in school all week (in case of changes to timetables).

As you know, much of the work we do in class is built on day by day; therefore, it is vital that the children are in school as much as possible and on time for the start of the school day (8.55am).
