Intervention Programmes

First Class at Number Maths Intervention

Intervention Summary:

1stClass@Number is a set of mathematics lessons. The teaching assistant usually works with a group of 4 children. The lessons are designed to be fun for the children, with lots of games and activities and discussion about the mathematics they are learning.

Intervention Objectives:

- To help improve a child's mathematical skills
- To develop mathematical vocabulary and to talk about how they do mathematics.
- To accelerate a child's progress in mathematics.
- To build confidence and enjoyment of mathematics

Length of Intervention:	12 to 14 weeks
Adult leading Intervention:	A trained and experienced teaching assistant
Frequency of intervention:	3 x 30 minutes per week The sessions take place in the afternoon so the children do not miss the daily class based maths and literacy teaching.

How you can help your child:

- Make sure your child is in school every day, so that he/she does not miss any FCAN lessons.
- Your child will sometimes bring home a mathematics activity to practise what they have learned. You will be asked to help them to do the activity and to talk about it.
- Be positive about maths!
