You should outline why you wish to be a parent governor and what you feel you can offer the governing body. You may include any information which you consider relevant – whether that be your work and life experiences, or your experience as a parent.

The closing date for the return of completed applications is Tuesday 30th March at 3.00pm. If we receive more than one application, the information on each nominee will be issued shortly after the closing date and parents will be invited to vote for their preferred candidate over a two/ three-week balloting period. Voting slips will be opened and counted shortly following the close of the ballot. Parents are welcome to attend the count.
