What we are learning this term

Our History topic this term is World War 2 and this will be the basis for much of the work that we do. This includes learning about the experience of living through a war and how it impacted on many people's lives. In English, we will be writing newspaper reports, diaries and biographies about key figures involved in the war, which we will learn about in our History lessons. For Maths we will begin working in our groups, learning about decimals and percentages, measure, algebra and statistics. We will also be doing some Maths linked to our topic where possible. In art, we are focussing on Henry Moore as well as some DT where we will make bunting. In Science, we will be learning about Light.
