What we are learning this term

This term our topic is The Rainforest where we will be learning about habitats, climates, deforestation and plants. In English, we will be looking at non-chronological reports and stories with morals. Most of our Maths sessions this term will be spent looking at measurements and time. Times table practice will also be vital to help the children with this term's Maths work. In Art, we will be studying the work of Henri Rousseau and recreating one of his famous pictures. In Science, we will be learning about classification of plants and also the human impact on the environment. In PE, we will be learning team games such a cricket and rounders.
